Where: On the grounds of the Rochester Country Fair under the big tent.
 Plumb Corner, Rt. 105, Rochester, MA 02770

Costs: \$10.00 Contestant Registration fee Youth and Novice, \$15.00 for all other classes.
 Fair admission is free

Constants/Registration:

Pre-Registration is by mail (with entry fee). Contestants may enter in one category only.
 Registration at the contest opens at 11AM and closes at 12:30PM. **Pre-registration is recommended.**
 **Also, due to the fair's parade route ~ all roads in and out of the fair grounds will be blocked off beginning at 10:00AM and will re-open upon return of the parade at approximately 12:00PM.
 Please plan to arrive accordingly.**

Registered contestants must sign in at the judges table **BEFORE** the contest begins to receive a Contestant Badge for playing order

Tentative Schedule:

Contest will be held rain or shine, there is no alternate date.
 Contestants will play in order of their Contestant Badge Number.
 Novices will play first, be judged and given ribbons immediately after the conclusion of their division.
 Since it is one long contest, there will be breaks at intervals for the judges during the contest.
 All contestants are invited to join in a final jam at the end of the day.

Contest Rules:

- 1.) Contest is open to players of acoustic violin family instruments.
- 2.) Contestant may enter only one category and play in order of their stated preference.
- 3.) All contestants have 8 minutes time on stage to play,
 (one) warm-up tune, (one) tune of choice*, and (one) waltz - no medleys
 * (Hoe-down, Reel, Hornpipe, Polka, Schottische, Jig, Slide, etc. but not a waltz and no double shuffle or trick bowing permitted.
- 4.) The Warm-Up Tune may be in any style. The Warm-Up Tune will not be judged and is optional.
- 5.) No music reading or music stands are allowed; playing will be from memory.
- 6.) One Accompanist is permitted in a backup and support role only (No Duets, etc.) We will not have a piano on site; but there will be electricity for a keyboard access.
- 7.) No medleys.

Judges and Judging Criteria:

Judging is based on contestant's performance and adherence to the rules. All judgments are final. Alternate judge will be on hand to judge contestants who are related to any of the regular judges. Contestants will be judged from 1 to 20 in each of the five criteria for the "contest" tune:

- 1. Rhythm & Timing;
- 2. Intonation & Pitch;
- 3. Technique;
- 4. Interpretation & Expression;
- 5. Difficulty of Selection

Directions:

Take Interstate 195 to the Rte. 105 exit # 20, Follow Rte. 105 signs to Rochester center, the fair is located at Plumb Corner on the right hand side.

Parking:

Pre-Registered Contestants will receive one parking pass via mail so long as applications are received prior to August 10th. Passes allow participants onto the fair grounds parking area. Contestants without a parking pass will be required to park in designated areas away from the fair grounds. There will be Handicapped parking and access.
